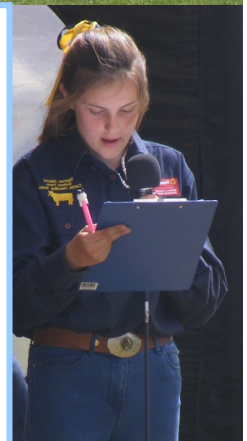


Tasman Hampshire Downs
